DURING CRUCIFIXION THE ARMS WERE OUTSTRETCHED ALONG THE PATIBULUM AND TIED OR NAILED.

THE NAILS WERE MADE FROM IRON AND WERE ABOUT FIVE TO SEVEN INCHES LONG.

THE NAILS WERE DRIVEN BETWEEN THE SMALL BONES OF THE HAND (CARPAL BONES) AND THE BONES AT THE END OF THE FOREARM (RADIUS & ULNA), WHICH MAKE THE WRIST JOINT.

IF A NAIL WAS ONLY THROUGH THE PALM, IT WOULD NOT SUPPORT THE WEIGHT OF THE HUMAN BODY AND WOULD TEAR. Nuormfuquf

FLOGGING OR SCOURGING WAS DONE BEFORE EVERY CRUCIFIXION. THE SCOURGING WAS INTENDED TO BRING A VICTIM TO A STATE JUST SHORT OF DEATH. THE WHIP HAD IRON BALLS TIED A FEW INCHES FROM THE END OF EACH LEATHER THONG ON THE WHIP. SOMETIMES, SHARP SHEEP BONES WOULD BE TIED NEAR THE ENDS. THE IRON BALLS WOULD CAUSE DEEP BRUISING, WHILE THE LEATHER THONGS WOULD CUT INTO THE SKIN. THE SHEEP BONES WOULD HASTEN THE PROCESS OF CUTTING INTO THE SKIN. AFTER A FEW LASHES, THE SKIN WOULD BE CUT THROUGH, AND THE MUSCLES WOULD BEGIN TO BE CUT. BLOOD LOSS WAS CONSIDERABLE, AND THE PAIN LIKELY PUT THE VICTIM IN A STATE OF SHOCK. Nursissifuquf

THE PRECISE CAUSE OF DEATH FROM CRUCIFIXION HAS BEEN DEBATED FOR YEARS.

D. A. CARSON SUMMARIZES:

"Whether tied or nailed to the cross, the victim endured countless paroxysms as he pulled with his arms and pushed with his legs to keep his chest cavity open for breathing and then collapsed in exhaustion until the demand for oxygen demanded renewed paroxysms. The scourging, the loss of blood, the shock from the pain, all produced agony that could go on for days, ending at last by suffocation, cardiac arrest, or loss of blood." Mossmfuqof

CRUCIFIXION WAS ONE OF THE MOST PAINFUL, CRUEL, AND MOST HUMILIATING FORMS OF PUNISHMENT EVER DEVISED BY MAN. THE JEWISH HISTORIAN JOSEPHUS DESCRIBES IT AS "THE MOST WRETCHED OF DEATHS", AND SENECA ARGUES THAT SUICIDE IS PREFERABLE TO THE CRUEL FATE OF BEING PUT ON THE CROSS.

THE WEIGHT OF THE ENTIRE CROSS WAS PROBABLY OVER 300 POUNDS, WHILE THAT OF THE PATIBULUM RANGED BETWEEN 75 AND 125 POUNDS. IT IS HIGHLY LIKELY THAT ONLY THE PATIBULUM WAS CARRIED AND THIS WAS PLACED ACROSS THE NAPE OF THE VICTIM'S NECK AND BALANCED ON BOTH SHOULDERS. Nursimfuquf

The cross was far more than an instrument of capital punishment. It was a public symbol of indecency and social indignity. Crucifixion was designed to do more than merely kill a man. Its purpose was to humiliate him as well. The cross was intended not only to break a man's body, but also to crush and defame his spirit.
